

**RIGHT-OF-WAY TREE PERMIT FOR
EMERALD ASH BORER TREATMENT**

PER ORDINANCE SEC. 35-21. Permits; trees on right-of-way.

- (a) *Required.* Except for employees or agents acting under the direction of the Director of Public Works, no person shall perform any of the following acts without having first obtained a permit from the Director of Public Works or in violation of the terms of such permit:
- (1) Plant, treat, trim, prune, root cut, remove, spray or damage any tree on public property; provided, however, that this provision shall not be construed to prohibit property owners from planting, watering, or maintaining trees in compliance with this article or to prevent imminent injury or damage to persons or property.
