

**COVID-19 RELATED
EMERGENCY ORDER 20-01
AMBULANCES**

The Mayor, upon recommendation of the City Manager and pursuant to Council Bill 2020-022 and Section 12-39 of the Champaign Municipal Code, hereby orders as follows:

Sec 5.5 50 EMT Requirements shall be amended for the period of the declaration of emergency as follows:

(a) When in use for emergency calls, each ambulance shall have as personnel in the ambulance at least one (1) EMT-P and one (1) EMT-B or two (2) EMT-P's on all emergency calls **coded by Emergency Medical Priority as Bravo, Charlie, Delta, and Echo. As a temporary measure, and during the time that the City of Champaign is under emergency order while dealing with the COVID-19 virus, the licensed ambulance provider may use an IDPH licensed basic ambulance staffed with two (2) EMT-Bs for response to calls coded by Emergency Medical Priority as Alpha and Omega.**

All amendments, activities, and/or authorizations permitted pursuant to this Order shall cease and become void upon termination of this Order.
